ARTICLE 2

The period of Mobility is composed of a compulsory, regular course study program effectuated during, and parallel to- the European (first) semester, for which the equivalent of 30 ECTS credits much be obtained, or a minimum of 12 Japanese credits. Each student is responsible to make sure his home (sending) department receives his/her credit transcript upon return from Japan.

ARTICLE 3

The compulsory study program will be followed by a personal research project or academic internship at the host (receiving) university research laboratory, of which expected results are defined in the study/research contract (Annex 1) between the undersigned student and his/her home (sending university).

ARTICLE 4

During the research period students can effectuate a professional internship either self-organized or via his/her research laboratory. The internship is subject to Japanese Law and can be accredited for a maximum of 2 Japanese credits only.

ARTICLE 5

The student is obliged to present results of his/her research or academic internship at the annual ‘Ausmip Join Evaluation’ which for the mobility cohort 2013-2014 will be organized in Japan end of May. Participation to the Joint Evaluation entitles the student to an Ausmip Certificate issued by the Sending and Receiving Departments under form of an addendum to his/her Master Degree.

ARTICLE 6

The undersigned student will receive a monthly stipend of 80.000 yen per month, with a maximum duration of 9 months, paid by JASSO.

Students who do not complete their full 9 month period shall be paid on a per diem basis for their final month of mobility.

ARTICLE 7

The undersigned student is entitled to guaranteed accommodation at his/her receiving (host) department’s student dormitories during his period of Mobility.

ARTICLE 8

The sending (home) department shall insure the student during his entire mobility, including social security, health insurance, personal liability and repatriation.

ARTICLE 9

The student shall provide the sending institution with up-to-date contact information enabling to contact next of kin in case of emergencies or natural disaster;
